Options for Installation of Litter Bin at the Playing Field – Feb 2021

Information from South Norfolk Council

All bins are owned installed and maintained by the respective parish and serviced (emptied) by South Norfolk Council.

Installation

The bin should be placed on either Parish owned or SNC land on a stand-alone pole concreted in to the ground and not fixed to any existing lampposts, signs or bus stops as these are owned by other agencies and could be removed without warning. Alternatively they can be situated on the ground as long as they are secured.

SNC recommend a company called Glasdon bins. The litter bins should be 110 litres due to weight (for manual handling during emptying). SNC also order liners in bulk and all one size, if the bins are any larger the liners fall in to the bin making them difficult to service.

Litter bins are a part of the statutory duty as a local authority to empty hence SNC issue no invoices for litter bin emptying. Bins will be emptied once a week.

Location alongside the current dog waste bin on the playing field in has been approved.
